I'm 83 years old, and I need help to care for myself, especially with bathing. Will Medicaid pay for this care?

Medicaid is the primary source of long-term care coverage for the elderly and peoples with disabilities, including middle-income individuals who spend down their financial resources. Medicaid covers skilled nursing-facility care, home health care and home- and community-based services.

According to your information you may be eligible for Medicaid covered home health care services.

However, the eligibility for Medicaid is based on your personal situation and is approved on a case by case basis. To check your eligibility and get more information regarding Medicaid services for seniors call us at Affinity.
